- Community colleges are two-year schools that offer career and transfer programs at an affordable price.



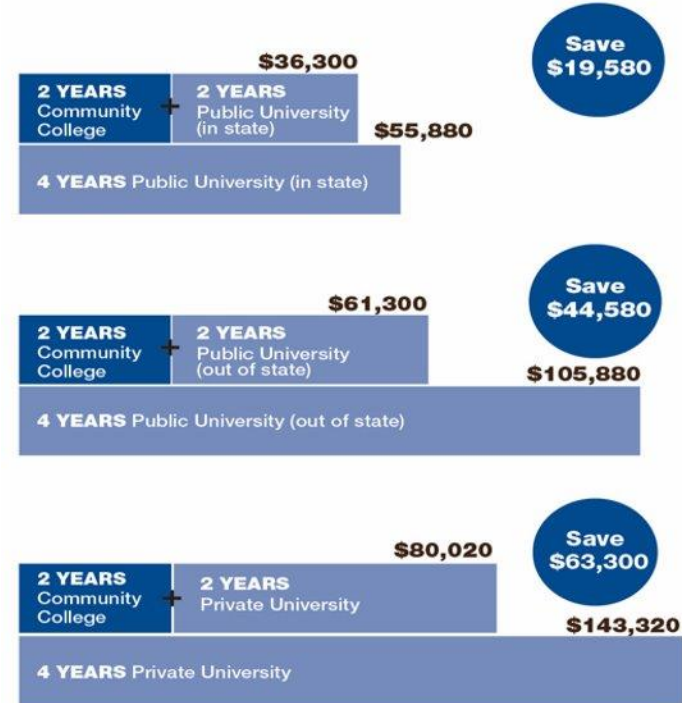
Top 5 Reasons to Attend Harper College

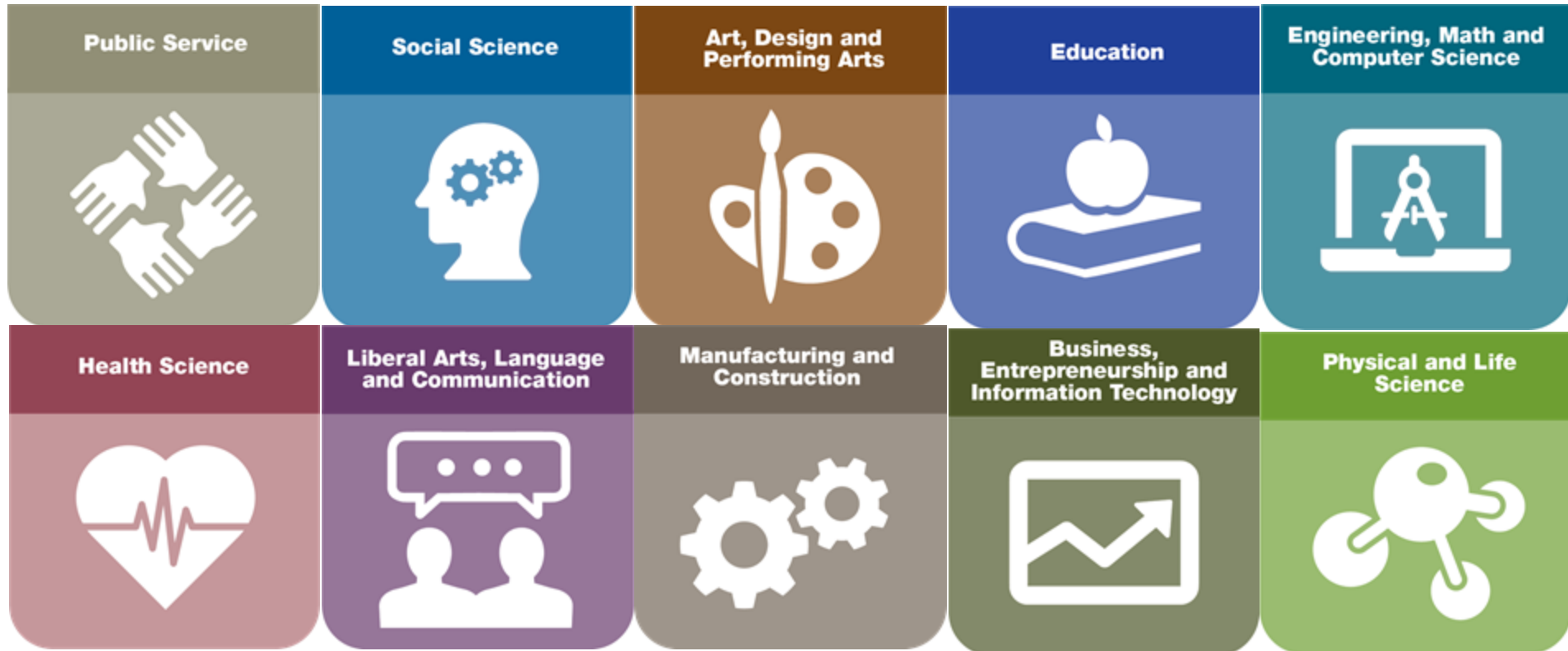
